Gourmet Baked Beans

2 tablespoons olive oil
Large tin baked beans
1 brown onion, diced
1 - 2 cloves garlic crushed
1/2 capsicum chopped
3 rashers of bacon
Juice of 1 lemon
1 tablespoon treacle
1 teaspoon English mustard

Place oil in large saucepan and fry onion, garlic, bacon and capsicum until tender. Add baked beans, lemon juice, treacle and mustard. Mix well and simmer until hot. Serve as desired and enjoy.
