Now for a recipe that is in tune with our show Cabaret:

German Apple Cake

125 gm butter 90 gm raw sugar 1 cup S/R flour 1 egg

Filling

3 granny smith apples 2 tablespoons sultanas 1 tablespoon raw sugar 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon 1/4 teaspoon nutmeg juice of 1 lemon

Melt butter in large saucepan, add sugar and stir till dissolved. Add flour and stir well, beat in egg. Spread 1/2 cake mixture over bottom of greased 18 cm. cake tin. Filling - Peel, core and slice apples, place 1/2 of these in layers over the cake mixture. Mix

Filling - Peel, core and slice apples, place 1/2 of these in layers over the cake mixture. Mix together sultanas, sugar and spices. Sprinkle over the apples, cover with remaining apples. Sprinkle with lemon juice. Spread remaining cake mixture in spoonfuls. Cook at 180 C for 45 minutes.
