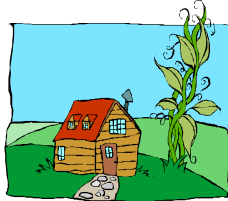

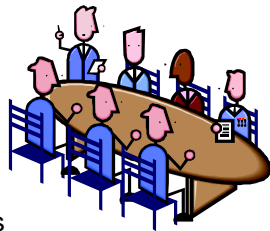
### **Joseph And The Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat**

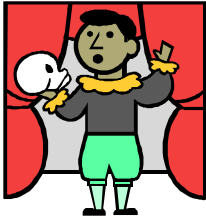

## *Aron in Theatreland*

With a little extra space left over this issue, I figured I'd add a new column to the newsletter, just to give a few reviews of what local theatrical productions I've seen this month.

Of course the biggest thing anywhere lately has been the **Gippsland Theatre Festival**. With workshops, performances and lots of other bits and pieces, the second Festival ever has been a great deal of fun, especially for this little participant. The climax, of course, would be the shows on both Friday and Saturday nights, emceed by Barry Whitehead and featuring a wide variety of performers from the Gippsland area. Highlights of the two evenings included our very own Merryn Degnan singing *Just One Step* and Ben Jenner with *Giants In The Sky* (giving us a taste of what delights are to come with *Into The Woods*), though I must say I was especially taken with **MOaRTZ's** *Not My Cup Of Tea* and **Twilight Theatre Factory's** *Double Tap*, two excellent one-act plays that had me riveted the whole time. Of course, I couldn't comment on the nights without mentioning the technical difficulties on Saturday night, expertly handled by Barry and the production team making what could have been catastrophic into one of the most hilarious moments of the night. Big applause all round.

I also had the opportunity this month to take a look at **Maffra Dramatic Society's** production of *Annie* over in Sale. While I'm not usually found to be engaged by musicals about singing orphans, **MDS** managed to overthrow my reservations with an excellent production. Bridey Harris as Annie gave a mature performance that belied her years, yet still captured a real sense of innocence and wonder at what she saw around her. When she calls out "Leapin' Lizards!", the audience believes it! The rest of the principal cast were also excellent – Adrian Cooper and Vicki Lanigan as Daddy Warbucks and Grace Farrell respectively getting me wishing that I could be adopted into the Warbucks household! Everyone on stage looked like they were having a ball, from the chorus to the orchestra – even director Robert Woodhouse in a surprise cameo!
